Motion for March 22 Church Conference

As many of you know, our current HVAC system is 55 years old. The Property Committee and the Finance and Budget Planning Committee have decided that it is prudent to upgrade this system. In September 2025, an engineer was hired to provide a specification for a system replacement. That specification was given to five reputable HVAC companies. We received four sealed bids, with the least expensive proposal being \$543,500. After two lengthy meetings, the Property Committee voted unanimously to authorize Reid Logan of JR Services, who has maintained our system for 20 years, to oversee the upgrade as general contractor, which would begin immediately. Please contact the Property Committee with your questions. The motion to be made from these committees next Sunday, March 22, at the Church Conference, is as follows:

That the Property Committee and the Finance and Budget Planning Committee spend funds over the next 18 months to hire JR Services of Pleasant Hill, MO, to act as general contractor for the installation of two new condensing boilers, as well as the remanufacture/rebuild of the existing AC condenser and air handler which supplies HVAC for the auditorium, fellowship hall, and surrounding rooms for a fee not to exceed \$225,000.

The vote for this motion will be by secret ballot at the Church Conference on Sunday, March 22, during the morning service.
