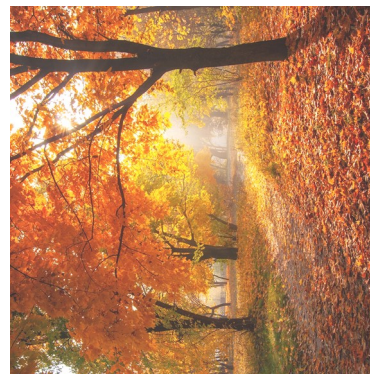

As with any and every family, we've had highs and lows. We've had lean times and times of profound fruitfulness. Regardless of whether we always saw or sensed God's blessings, we've always known that "He abides faithful" (2 Timothy 2:13).

I believe I can speak to this as I've been deeply involved at RBBC since 1980. Literally, I've been blessed to be part of this wonderful church for 75% of our entire history.

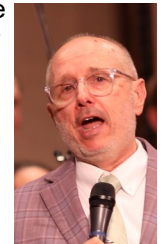
So, why can I say that RBBC has always experienced the faithfulness of God? I'll offer a number of reasons. First, God has blessed us in that each of the five Pastors (including when we were a mission chapel from 1963-65) has held the highest view of the Word of God. Each Pastor brought the truth from the conviction that Scripture is the inspired, inerrant, authoritative written Word of the living God! That is a HUGE blessing from the Lord to this local church. "Thank you, Lord!"

Second, Red Bridgers have been blessed with a strong sense of community. In 60 years, there have certainly been times of struggle. Yet, this local church remains strong and fruitful to this very day. "Thank you, Lord!"

Third, RBBC has been debt-free for well over 40 years. It's not uncommon for local churches to struggle and close the doors due to financial stresses. To be sure, RBBC is not financially affluent, but, suffice it to say that we are blessed with a flawless track record of paying our bills. Thank you, Lord!

Fourth, Red Bridgers have always been a welcoming people. In fact, currently we might be realizing this to the greatest degree as there are believers from over a dozen countries represented in the congregation. RBBC looks a bit like Heaven in ethnic diversity. Thank you, Lord!

Fifth, longevity of membership is common at RBBC. There are many followers of Christ at RBBC who have been members for over 30 years, and some over 40-50 years! I want to mention two such folks. Brother Mark Saylor has been the Director of Music Ministries for about 33 years. That's well over half the life of the church. It's profoundly unusual for a Pastor and worship leader to be on the same platform together for this long; and, we've been blessed to experience this without a single argument or break in fellowship. Truly, Thank you, Lord!



Sister Wanda Jackson ministered in the church office for 42.5 years. That's amazing! Thank you Wanda for the tens of thousands of hours you devoted to serving the Lord and your fellow Red Bridgers. Your labor is NOT in vain! Thank you, Lord!

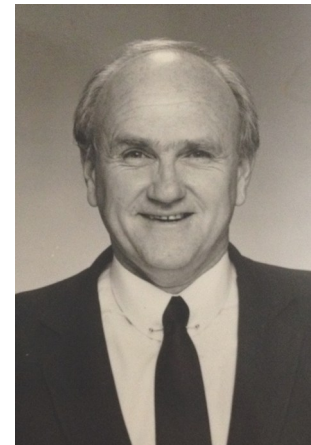
