As most know, 2025-26 is the RBBC Year of **Being People of the Book!** Many Red Bridgers (and others from around the country/world have also joined in) are reading through the Word of God this year. As of the date of this article, we're about 42% of the way through our reading.

I want to remind everyone of the admonition of Scripture regarding, not just the reading of God's Word, but obeying what it says. James 1:22 issues the command to *"...be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only..."*

So, in addition to reading, are you obeying the Word of God? It's wise, as a follower of Christ, to ask oneself: *"Is there any area of my life which is NOT surrendered to the will of God as revealed in the Word of God?"* I want to offer some areas of the Christian life which should be considered when asking that question.

First, I should take inventory of my spiritual life. This is an obvious area. This includes the various disciplines of my life in Christ, including: Bible reading, prayer, service, financial stewardship, evangelism, fellowship, etc. The Word of God speaks frequently and clearly on each of these spiritual disciplines.

Second, I should make sure my own family life is in order according to scriptural precepts/principles. Almost every believer has close family relationships which should be functioning biblically. The world needs to see what Spirit-controlled family members look like!

Third, my ecclesiastical (local church) life is profoundly important. It seems that the 21st-century American church has placed commitment/involvement in the local church on the back burner. Brethren—let not this be the case in your life. Hebrews 10:24-25 makes it clear that the gathering of God's people is a priority.

Fourth, a believer's body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor.6:19-20). I'm to care for God's temple. Sir: this admonition is especially for you. It's well known that males are not usually as intentional about taking care of physical health as is the female gender.

Fifth, a believer's relational life is also quite important. Is there anyone in your life with whom you are not in good standing? Do you find yourself avoiding interacting with someone at church, in your family, work, etc.? The Word of God not only tells us about life, but it speaks very clearly about how to live. Again, we're to be *"...doers of the Word, and not hearers only..."*!

I know, I know, an article like this is "preachy." I stand on solid ground because the issues I've brought to our attention are not personal opinions. These disciplines are clearly established in God's Word, as well as many others. What's the point? The point is that reading, studying, understanding, and obeying/applying the principles of the written Word of God will always change one's life! What's more, the changes will honor the Lord, bless your

own life (and those around you), as well as enhance your testimony in the eyes of those outside of Christ. Give yourself to knowing and obeying the Word of God. You'll not regret it!!!
